Bogus Basin is the first mountain recreation area in the state of Idaho to feature an Alpine Mountain Coaster. Experience 4,330 feet of twisting and turning track that winds through the woods as it reaches speeds of 25 plus miles per hour and heights of 40 plus feet in the air. The Bogus Basin Glade Runner allows you to experience the mountain like never before. The carts are pulled to the top of the track by an independent lift, then released for an exhilarating ride through the trees. You are in control of your own speed. Each cart can accommodate two riders, one driver and one rider (subject to combined weight and age restrictions). The Glade Runner operates in both summer and winter.

## IDAHO STATE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

The Idaho State Museum will be reopening on October 12, 2018 after undergoing a \$17 million renovation and expansion. This is the first complete renovation of the museum since it opened in 1950. The new exhibitions will reflect the premise that people and the land shape each other. Idaho's story will be told geographically focused on northern Idaho, central Idaho, and southern Idaho. This story is the work of years of scholarly research, community focus groups, and input from community, tribal, and business leaders. New exhibitions in the Idaho State Museum will engage visitors through a variety of methods. Visitors will actually be able to feel the heat of the "Big Burn", take a ride on a Salmon River Scow, or turn off the water to Shoshone Falls.
